Watermain Cleaning and Relining on Osler Street from Cariboo Avenue to Pelham Avenue ROAD CLOSURE

Contract No. 17TW-OS-02CWD
Road Closure Dates: Thursday, November 1 to Friday, November 16, 2018
Expected Duration: 10-15 days

As part of the watermain cleaning and relining project on Osler Street, a temporary road closure will be required between Pelham Avenue and Cariboo Avenue.





The lane closures and restrictions are as follows:

- From Thursday, November 1 to Friday, November 16 traffic will be reduced to one shared lane in both directions from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. However, the road will be completely closed to vehicle traffic from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Construction hours for this project are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (no work on Sundays)
- Pedestrian access along the sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- Traffic control and flagmen will be in place during these hours to direct vehicles.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

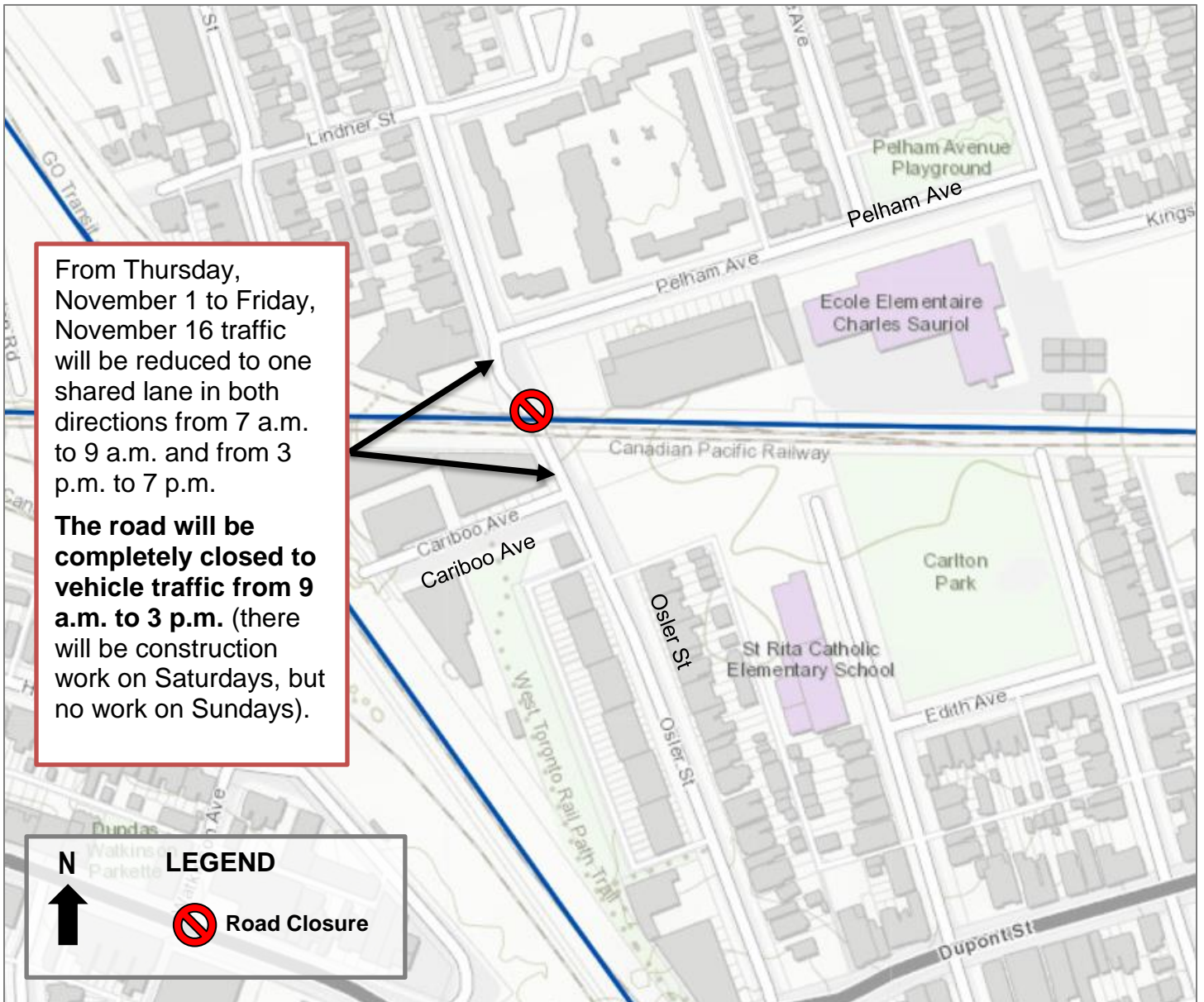
- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences during this work. The City will make every effort to reduce the impact. We appreciate your patience.

	Overnight Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday. Night work may be required as part of this project. You will be notified in advance of any changes to work hours.
	Water Service Disruption: The water supply to your property may need to be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice for all planned shut-offs. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advanced notice, an emergency water shut off could have been necessary.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and pedestrians. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
